TITAN® BOOT CAMP: THREE DAY INTERMEDIATE COURSE

The TITAN® Intermediate Boot Camp is a three-day course that will benefit LIMS users as well as QA/QC laboratory managers, analysts (chemists, microbiologists), system administrators, and those IT personnel responsible for supporting the LIMS. This course will also be beneficial for those responsible for reporting, QC charts and data analysis and want to get the most out of their TITAN® LIMS investment.
